

## **Racquetball Club of Sun City Rules & Regulations**

The purpose of the Racquetball Club of Sun City is to bring a clear understanding of the proper usage of the available facilities, promote physical fitness for members and generate a greater participation in the game of racquetball among the people of Sun City.

### **Revised Rules and Regulations (updated 12/12/2015)**

1. The Racquetball Club shall adhere to all regulations of RCSC BP No. 12 for Chartered Clubs. Executive Board Members will make themselves aware of all phases of BP No. 12.
2. The Club's Executive Board shall consist of at least (3) members: President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer. Any Club Member may volunteer to serve on the Board as a Member at Large or a Committee Member. The Board will to be voted upon by office at the last regular membership meeting of the year and shall serve for (1) calendar year term. There will be no term limits. The Board shall meet in session at least (2) times per year within Club Membership meetings. The President shall preside at all Club meetings and direct all Club activities. The Vice President shall assist the President in all duties and shall preside in the absence of the President. The Secretary/Treasurer will maintain all record keeping and financial reporting. The President may fill any Board or Committee vacancies prior to the end of their term.
3. The yearly Club membership fee will be \$5.00. The Executive Board may change the amount of the fee by a Member vote at the final meeting of each year and to be made effective the following year. Recurring membership fees are due and payable between January 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. New membership applications received after September 30 each year will be prorated to include the following calendar year.
4. Members and escorted guests must comply with current RCSC & Racquetball Club rules and regulations. Visitors who are RCSC card holders are always welcome to play during Club hours.
5. Players must provide and wear the proper equipment which includes safety eye protection, a corded racquet tethered to the player's wrist and clean indoor court only footwear.
6. The President, Vice President and Treasurer must all be signatories on any club bank account. Only the President or the Treasurer is required to sign checks.
7. Only Club Members have voting rights on any subject brought before the Executive Board and presented to the membership for a vote.
